A. Clarke Report

Mr. Balis stated that the District is not currently on the drought map due to recent rains higher than other areas. The District has seen an increase in positive WNV samples and there have been human cases, which is earlier than normal. Based on these high numbers, Clarke is more than likely going to recommend treatment in Highland Park.

A question was asked about the number of traps used. Mr. Balis stated that there is reliability in all numbers but more traps give better scope of the issues at hand. He said that the CDC wants better records of numbers and targeted decisions. Gravit traps have been used as they provide the information the District and CDC seek.

President Ross stated that the plan is to release the RFP by the end of the month and hopefully have responses due in September that decisions can be made at the October meeting. The main plan is to overhaul the website, provide digital marketing and community outreach.
